(For the period 9/1/16 – 8/31/17)***

I, the undersigned _____ (*print name of individual*), in consideration for the use of Deerfield Academy's facilities (other than the Fitness Center), on behalf of myself, with full knowledge, agree to release any and all claims and agree to hold harmless and indemnify Deerfield Academy, its Board of Trustees, officers, agents, employees, and volunteers from any and all past, present, and future claims suffered by any person due to any cause including but not limited to negligence, breach of contract or breach of warranty, including reasonable attorney's fees and cost, which arises from, or relates to, the individual's use of Deerfield Academy's facilities. This agreement shall be construed pursuant to Massachusetts law and jurisdiction shall be in Franklin County, Massachusetts.

Physical Condition and Insurance Requirements: The undersigned attests that they are physically capable and have no known health restrictions that might jeopardize his/her safety or health, or the safety or health of others, during their activity. They further attest that they have evidence of medical insurance that is in effect the dates of when they are on campus.

Rules and Regulations: The undersigned understands and agrees to abide by all policies, rules and regulations of Deerfield Academy; and understands that in its sole discretion that Deerfield Academy or its representative may terminate the activity at any time. Deerfield Academy Campus Rules

Physical safety and emotional safety are a high priority in the Deerfield community. A safe environment assures the capacity of individual to reach for high goals. Within this context, we state a few simple but important rules:

In an emergency, coach or event supervisor should call 911 (if needed) AND Deerfield Academy's Campus Security at 413-772-9880 immediately.

Drugs and Alcohol: Drug or alcohol use on or off campus is against the law, unless it is provided at a scheduled school sanctioned event on campus. It constitutes a serious threat to the health and safety of all individuals on campus. The Academy forbids the use, purchase, attempted purchase, possession and sale of alcohol and illegal drugs. Similarly, it forbids the possession of equipment or paraphernalia involved in the use of illegal drugs.

Prescribed Medicine and Homeopathic Remedies: The Academy forbids the misappropriation or misuse of prescription drugs. Misappropriation includes acquiring drugs from any source, including the Internet, other than a designated health care coordinator. Misuse includes taking a prescription drug or being in possession of a prescription drug that has not been prescribed for your use.

Use of Tobacco: Individuals on campus are not permitted to smoke or chew tobacco in any Academy buildings. Deerfield hosts are also responsible for their guest's adherence to this regulation.

Respectful behavior: The Deerfield community thrives on trust and respect and every member has the right to feel safe. Physical, written (including cyber-bullying), or verbal behavior, which is harmful to others, uninvited and/or unwanted, will not be tolerated in any form, including equally damaging forms of harassment such as graffiti, epithets, stereotypical remarks of "humor" or any behavior that contributes to the creation of a hostile environment in which to live and learn. Harassment is any abuse of an individual or group based on ethnic origin, religious beliefs, race, sexual orientation, gender, age or grade in school. Individuals who break these rules will be asked to leave the Deerfield community.

Cell Phone Use: Cell phones are not to be used in public on campus. If you need to take a call or text someone, please do so in a semi-public location discretely.

Hazing: Note: Illegal in Massachusetts. The Deerfield community does not tolerate humiliating or potentially harmful "rites of passage" or "initiations" and such behavior will result in your being asked to leave the Deerfield community.

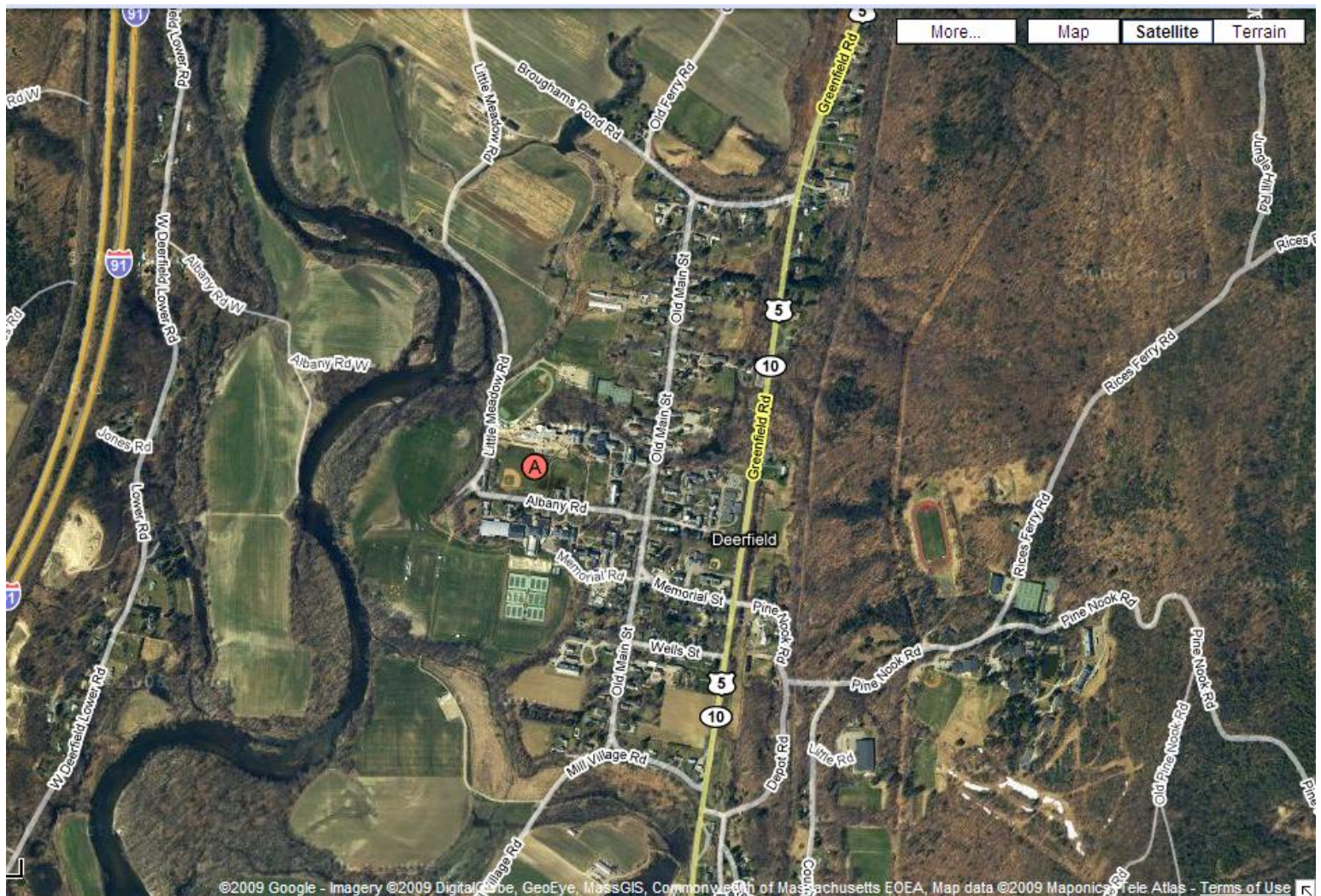
Gambling: Gambling for money is prohibited.

Physical Safety: Safety is our highest priority. Weapons, ammunition, fireworks, explosives, and harmful devices will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Individuals who break these rules will be asked to leave the Deerfield community.

Vandalism: Purposeful destruction or damage to school property or the property of an individual will not be tolerated. Included in this rule is that individuals using Deerfield Academy's facilities will respect each other's personal space, as well as their belongings.

Fire Safety: Secured external doors (including fire exits) may not be used by any individual on campus.

Physical boundaries of the Deerfield Academy campus: To insure safety, it is important to utilize only those spaces your group was contracted with to use. Do not enter any building(s) unless prior permission has been granted.



Directions to Deerfield Academy

From the South

Driving to the Academy from the south, take I-91 North to Massachusetts exit 24 and turn right at the end of the exit ramp. Head north on Routes 5 and 10 for five miles, turning left at the "Historic Deerfield" sign onto Main Street. Half a mile on the left is the Academy.

From the North

Driving from the north, take I-91 South to exit 25, and turn left at the end of the ramp. At the stop sign, turn left onto Routes 5 and 10 and proceed north for approximately four miles. Turn left at the "Historic Deerfield" sign onto Main Street and proceed about a half mile to the Academy.

From the East

Driving from the east, take I-90 West (the Massachusetts Turnpike) to exit 4. Head north on I-91 and follow "from the south" directions above. Or take Route 2 west to I-91 South and follow "From the North" directions above.

From the West

Driving from the west, take I-90 East (the Massachusetts Turnpike) to exit 4. Head north on I-91 and follow "From the South" directions above. Or take Route 2 east to I-91 South and follow "From the North" directions above.

Parking: Follow Old Main Street to Albany Road. At the end of Albany Road (past the baseball field on your right), take a right onto Little Meadow Road (Barton Dorm at corner on your right). Park behind the Koch Science Center or down Little Meadow Road. Parking is also available on Albany Road and Barton Circle (where Albany Road and Little Meadow Road intersect).
